- Noted putting an exclusion fence around any Queensland National Park (QP&W) is not in the Policy and he does not have the authority to change a Policy. However he is here to help and to take information back to his superiors.
- All neighbours of a National Park have the right to put up an exclusion fence around their property, however QP&W will only assist with maintenance to the standard of a stock fence.
- QP&W have always participated in wild dog baiting and done land baiting along water courses and boundaries. Grid baiting has not been done at Bladensburg but have baited water courses and targeted groups of dogs.
- QP&W is always willing to work with neighbours.
- Artificial water sources increase the number of kangaroos and wild dogs.
