Dear Winton Shire Council Residents

I would like to advise that I have submitted my formal resignation as a Councillor to Mayor Baskett and Mr Ricki Bruhn CEO Winton Shire Council and will be stepping down from my role effective from the 18 December 2020.

As many residents may be aware, I have recently been appointed as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Western Queensland Primary Health Network (WQPHN). My appointment to this role is a recognition of my 25 plus years' experience and commitment to rural and remote health. I see this appointment as both an honour and privilege to be able to serve all communities across the Western Queensland catchment.

The CEO role has a commanding workload and will require extensive travel outside of the Winton Shire and Central West region. The WQPHN's goal is to improve the integration of primary care services across our shared communities and covers approximately one million square kilometres of Western Queensland region which represents 55% of the Qld State. The decision to resign from Council, has been a difficult one to make; I do not however feel I would be able to continue to effectively represent the interests of the Winton Community and also perform to the professional standards and expectations of a locally elected member.

I would like to personally thank all the residents that had the confidence in me at the Election in 2020. I have enjoyed my term on Council and have learnt a considerable amount about the internal workings of Local Government. I would like to thank Councillors' Seymour, White, Mann, Elliot and Mayor Baskett for the professional etiquette shown to me over the past eight months and wish them all the best in their future endeavours.

In closing, I will remain in the Winton Community and have secured a lease at the old dental clinic where my main office will be located along with my colleague, Leisa Fraser Coordinator Commissioning & Alliancing WPQHN.

I would like to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a safe and prosperous New Year.

Winton Golf Club 2020 Wrap-Up

Winton Golf Club held their Annual Presentation of Trophies Saturday 5th December concluding another successful year of competition golf which was quite different in some ways and will be remembered as the "Year of Covid-19". With a temporary closure to the course and clubhouse from the 29th March following advice from Golf Australia and the Qld. Chief Health Officer in relating to outdoor events, one of the changes to the yearly program was no golf competitions held during the month of April due to Covid-19 restrictions.

Highlights for the 2020 Season:

- **Diamantina Open** Golf Championships normally played in August had to be re-scheduled to September due to the uncertainty with the ever changing restrictions of the Covid-19 pandemic. The event was successful with a field of over 50 golfers competing and travelling from Townsville, Mt. Isa, Richmond, Hughenden, Boulia, Cloncurry, Longreach, Ilfracombe, Jundah, Isisford, Muttaburra, and Blackall.
- **FREE Junior Golf** coaching Clinics conducted by PGA Kevin Carruthers held in September with a number of juniors receiving coaching. One of the Clubs aims is to build its player base and foster junior golf, and it is through on-going golf clinics that this interest in sport will strengthen. Interesting to note there are only (6) full playing junior members in the Golf North Queensland Western Zone.
- The **Men's GNQ Western Zone Inter-Association** event was cancelled for 2020 due to Covid-19. Golf North Queensland conducted the **Golfer of the Year** event for the Western Zone Clubs (Mt. Isa, Hughenden, Richmond, Boulia & Winton). The A Grade winner for 2020 - B. Lenton, B Grade G. Sealy (Hughenden) and C Grade P. Franzmann (Hughenden). Ladies Gross and Nett winners were Maree Norman & Amanda Alloway (Hughenden Golf Club)
- **Grant Funding** for Clubhouse improvements were successful for the renewal of the eastern entry with new covered roof, landing and stairway with funding support through the Winton Shire Council's Drought Communities Program. Several other grant funding applications were successful; including the purchase of a water bubbler, construction for a new stairway to No. 5 raised tee-off, and awaiting outcome of funding this month to construct a walkway bridge over the watercourse fairway section following damage during the 2019 NW Monsoonal flooding event.





Winton Shire Council (WSC) would like to advise the community of a data collection project run by our Rural Lands & Biosecurity officers. The project aims to collect data using a simple and easy form requesting GPS points of wild dog sightings (whether baited, shot or trapped).

All information collected will be generated into an online database, displaying all sightings of wild dogs within the shire. The collection of this data will support WSC when applying for future funding opportunities, whilst also improving WSC and landholder's biosecurity obligations and responsibilities relating to wild dog management.




