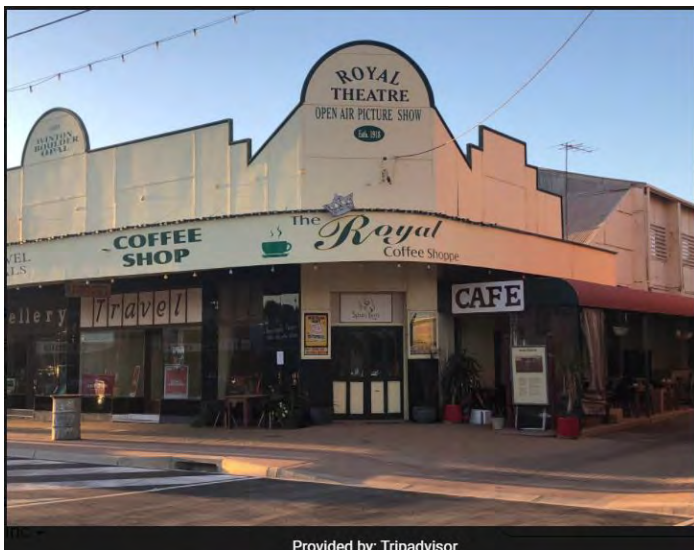

Royal Theatre gets new Life

Recent weeks have seen a team from the extended Evert family, travelling back to Winton from all around Queensland, to complete the first round of renovations in their quest to bring the iconic Royal open-air Theatre back to life. This iconic 103-year-old theatre is just one of two open-air theatres still operating in Australia and it had been in the Evert family since 1937. The team are supporting the small not for profit organisation, Winton Movies Inc (WMI), who have been established to bring the Royal Theatre Winton back to life.

Geraldine Coughlan, daughter of Vince Evert, is passionate about the project and says she wants to build on the family's lifetime preservation of the theatre. Importantly, Geraldine says, "this is a unique opportunity to evolve the theatre into a world class multipurpose facility and for it to become a cultural epicentre for the local Winton community and the Queensland outback."



James Evert adds, "Our heritage is in Winton and we see this project will bring new audiences and new events to Winton, contributing to sustainable economic and employment activity for the region."

WMI member Lydia Evert also chairs the Business Development subcommittee. She says, "We are a group of passionate volunteers who are motivated to support the region and we can't wait to see our big plans for this old girl. Everyone we talk to is excited

about the project and we are building a fantastic network of partners who are right behind us. I can't thank Gavin Baskett and the Winton Shire Council enough for their support. Likewise, we have had great support from local business and tourism associations."

WMI is currently completing the first stage of the renovations, primarily in the Candy Bar. This is currently being funded through grants and a fundraising campaign will contribute to completing the works. Project Manager Gavin Evert said, "After we complete the Candy Bar, we need to enclose the projection room to protect the equipment from the elements.

Minister views Grasshopper devastation

Last Saturday (6 March 2021) Minister for Agricultural Industry Development the Honourable Mark Furner MP visited Winton to meet with Winton Shire Councils elected members and local graziers to see firsthand the impact of the recent grasshopper plague on the grazing industry.



While in Winton Minister Furner visited Oondoroo Station and met with local graziers Jason Turnbull, Bruce & Madison Godfrey and Chris Meikle to hear about the devastation of the country and its impact on their business, this is the third year running for many places in the district where long awaited rain has produced some grass only for it be decimated by the marauding insects

A Working Group has been established by Department of Agriculture & Fisheries to gather information and work

toward a long-term solution, Minister Furner has pledged to support this group for as long as needed to find a solution.

Minister Furner was accompanied in Winton by DAF staff who gave an update on their progress as well as what they are hoping to achieve going forward, their hope is to have an Australian Pesticides & Veterinary Medicines Authority Permit within the next week to allow graziers access to an accredited chemical.

The Minister expressed his gratitude to those present for their time to attend and especially to Mr Turnbull for allowing access to his property.

Winton's Mayor Gavin Baskett said " It was great to have Minister Furner in Winton on Saturday to see first hand the devastation the grasshopper plague is causing, we have been lobbying hard to get some assistance for our Graziers because this is the third year in a row that many of our properties have been eaten out by grasshoppers, I'm hoping the establishment of this working group will come up with a long term solution"

BURNING TO ESTABLISH PASTURE SEED SOURCES FOR FUTURE REHABILITATION

*With the prickles under control and grass established, it's
time to clean up areas through burning to maximise soil
carbon and promote good ground cover.*



When combined with wet season spelling and careful
management, these sites have the potential to be used for
harvesting of seed to quickly re-establish grass cover in
degraded areas.

This will be an informal paddock walk and talk to discuss the
plans and to prepare the area for a burn.

On the agenda:

- Prickly Acacia control,
- maximising soil moisture and minimising runoff,
- the recovery cycle,
- beneficial burns and
- grazing management for weed control and recovery

Getting there:

From Winton, take the Landsborough Highway toward
Kynuna for 70 km, then turn left onto Dagworth Cemetery
Road. Follow the DCQ field day signs from there.
