## Neighbouring councils put aside football rivalry in major tourism push

Longreach Regional Council and Winton Shire Council are partnering in a major destination marketing campaign aimed at promoting the two regions to city audiences.

The cross-media campaign will feature television commercials aired in metro markets including Brisbane and Sydney, as well as major regional coastal centres. It will be supported by targeted social media and a new destination website, [experience-longreach-and-winton.com.au](http://experience-longreach-and-winton.com.au).

The two councils signed a Memorandum of Understanding last year to cooperate on Tourism, leading to the development of the Longreach and Winton Sub-Region Tourism Activation Plan 2019 – 2024. The initiative aims to capitalise on over \$50M worth of State and Federal funding invested in new Tourism product between the two communities in recent years. There is also a focus on promoting the two regions as a year-round destination.

Longreach Mayor Tony Rayner said the two communities share a common interest in Tourism.

“Between the two of us we have the biggest attractions in Outback Queensland, but we also have the most product, including a lot of mature wholesale product that’s already built around visiting Longreach and Winton together.”

Winton Mayor Gavin Baskett, who is an experienced rugby league referee, said despite a fierce football rivalry there are more things that unite the towns than the things that divide them.

“The Tourism industry in our two regions is more developed than in other places, so it makes sense for us to work together. But we’ve also got this shared history with strong links to Australia’s bush heritage. You can see that in our big attractions like the Waltzing Matilda Centre and the Australia Stockman’s Hall of Fame.”

Both towns also feature in the history of Qantas, with the Qantas Founders Museum in Longreach launching major upgrades recently. Mayor Rayner said both communities are proud of their connections to the Qantas story.

“Yeah, they never let us forget that Winton was the where the company was formed before relocating to Longreach” he said with a wry smile. “But that’s just the point – you have this incredibly remote part of the world that those founders decided could be linked by an air service.

“We may still be remote, but we’re not isolated, and it’s never been easier to get here – which is what this new campaign is all about.”

Mayor Baskett agrees.

“We want everyone to experience what we have out here - our dark skies, our ancient landscapes, our way of life, and our rich history.”

He said the region’s historic significance has taken on a new dimension with the establishment of the Australian Age of Dinosaurs Museum.

“We’ve always been famous for our history but now, thanks to the Australian Age of Dinosaurs, we can trace it back 145 million years!”

The mayors said they hoped the partnership would benefit the rest of Outback Queensland too.

“Ultimately, we all want the same thing for our region” said Mayor Rayner. “I think by working together, we’ll actually make a difference to the whole of Outback Queensland – beyond just our two towns.”

The cross-media campaign will go to air this week and run through July and August.

## Winton Mayor Gavin Baskett joins Drought and flood Agency Advisory Board



Coordinator-General of the National Drought and North Queensland Flood Response and Recovery Agency, the Hon Shane L Stone AC QC, has welcomed Winton Mayor, Councillor Gavin Baskett, to the Agency's Advisory Board.

Meeting this week in Canberra, the Board continues to advise on ways the Agency can best support regional and rural Australians through challenges like drought, COVID-19 and ongoing recovery from the 2019 North Queensland floods.

"Our boots-on-the-ground approach continues to keep us in touch with farmers and producers and their communities across the nation," Mr Stone said. "Having community leaders like Gavin on my Advisory Board is another important way I can hear what matters in the regions."

To ensure a continued strong focus on the ongoing recovery of North and North-West Queensland following the 2019 flood event, the Board's membership includes representation from a Mayor from one of the worst affected shires.

Cr Baskett succeeds Cloncurry Mayor, Greg Campbell, who has been a Board

member from the Agency's foundation and has been a strong advocate for communities across the Gulf country and beyond.

"Our plan has always been to rotate the membership of local government leaders from the region, so we continue to get a diversity of advice and expertise," Mr Stone said.

"Greg's contribution has been outstanding and he will continue to be a go-to source of information as our staff and I visit the region to listen to the communities about what's working - and what still needs doing - during their years of recovery."

Cr Baskett's experience in Winton will also be crucial to all aspects of the Agency's work.

"Winton has been belted by drought, then the flood and now drought's back again. They also have the additional pestilence of large grasshopper numbers that ravage feed and regrowth.

Add to that the local impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, and Gavin Baskett will play a major role in keeping us updated with conditions and how we can best support regional

communities through the range of challenges they face," Mr Stone said. The National Drought and Flood Agency is built on a strategy of being on the ground with its communities. Mr Stone has covered many thousands of kilometres with staff and Board members, listening to producers, small business owners and other community members, to understand their needs and how their ongoing recovery is best supported.

In the month of June 2020, the Agency's Regional Recovery Officers travelled almost 14,000 kilometres throughout rural and regional Australia, fulfilling the Agency's commitment to maintain a strong regional presence. Rae has also been growing lots of vegetables this year and received some gardening supplies for her prizes. The Garden Club was overwhelmed by the support of this initiative and glad to see that it somehow managed to bring the community together and doing productive things during isolation.

## A message from the Police

Winton Police have recently been required to take action on a number of matters that could have easily been avoided if contact details were up to date. 


