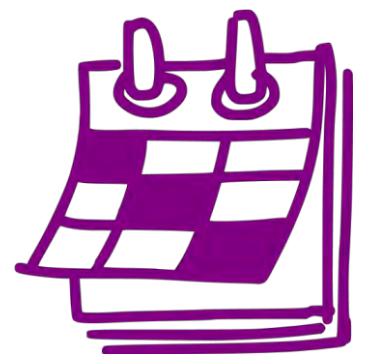

In last week's Longreach Leader an article announced that a new building was to be constructed as a meeting place for Winton youth.

It brought back to me memories of our first Youth Centre that opened in 1982 in the unused church building. (That's close to 40 years ago. Can it be?) In the beginning it simply served as a five-days-a-week after-school drop-in centre supervised by a roster of parents. Support by the community led to repairs and refurbishments. The table tennis and pool tables were in constant use and we held regular competitions. A couple of trampolines outside catered for the more energetic. Interests of the students in those days and the activities they enjoyed were, I suppose, unsophisticated compared with the present day. As time went on we established a BMX Club competing on Saturday afternoons. Fondest memories though, I think, would be of our regular Friday night Discos which ran for many years, with flashing lights, mirror ball 'n' all.

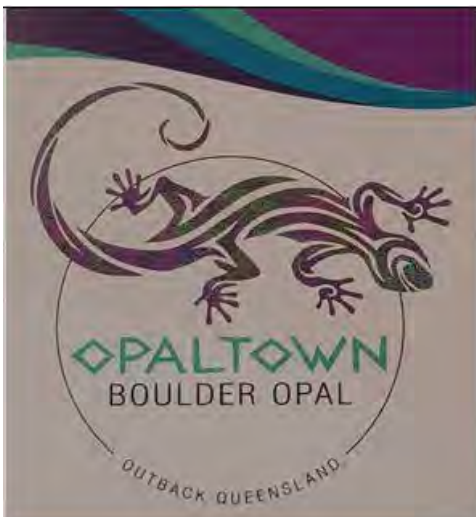
