Mr & Mrs E Perry and Miss Joan Mitchell all directed a soft drink booth, with good results and Mr A. Elliott acted as starter.

The net financial result amounting to 45 pounds.

Sheep and goat industry update for Longreach

Leading Sheep and Meat & Livestock Australia (MLA) are encouraging red meat and wool producers to register for the Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum that will focus on both production and business management topics at Longreach on Friday, 25 March 2022.

Together, Leading Sheep and MeatUp bring you an event addressing key priorities for goat, sheepmeat and wool businesses including reproduction; restocking and rebuilding; nutritional requirements and supplementary feeding; key business metrics and return on capital investments. Plus, the Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum offers a great opportunity to network with fellow producers and industry representatives through the day and during the Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum Dinner.

The collaborative event features a red meat market update from MLA General Manager Research, Development & Adoption, Michael Crowley, and a wool industry update from Emily King, AWI Program Manager, Research & Extension.

Gordon Refshauge, NSW DPI, will focus on improving sheep reproductive performance to increase productivity and profitability, and Rob Inglis of Elders will address sheep feed intake and nutrition requirements from joining through to weaning.

Lester Pahl, of QDAF, will explore the equivalency of sheep and goats from an intake/DSE perspective, how quickly goats reproduce and the subsequent impact on grazing pressure, and Gordon Refshauge will also address why maiden does may be the weak link in reaching greater weaning rates for goats.

Michael Crowley, MLA General Manager Research, Development & Adoption, said there's something at the Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum for all sheep and goat producers.

"In addition to production-oriented topics, there is also a business management focus. John Francis of Agrista will provide insights into the MLA goat benchmarking project and will talk on both quantitative and qualitative costs to be aware of for infrastructure projects. Recruitment and retention of

team members and diversification into tourism are also explored."

The Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum Dinner follows the Forum and promises to be an exciting end to the day. Louise Moore, Project Manager of Leading Sheep, is encouraging producers to travel to Longreach, saying 'the Leading Sheep MeatUp Forum and Dinner is a great opportunity to catch up with fellow producers and industry representatives. Producers will also enjoy hearing from guest speaker, Dennis Hoiberg, with his unique insights into emotional wellbeing, resilience and thriving through change.'

Registration is essential, online at mla.com.au/meatup or phone 1300 746 466. Given current COVID-19 requirements, all people attending must be symptom free and double vaccinated.

Grant program to help Maranoa's sporting events bounce back

Sporting events across Maranoa are set to benefit from the Coalition Government's Regional Sport Events Fund.

Now open for applications, the fund will support community sporting events across the region with an aim of kick-starting the economy and encouraging visitors back to Maranoa communities.

Funding of up to \$50,000 will be available to over 400 eligible Local Government Areas (LGAs) in Very Remote, Remote, Outer Regional and Inner Regional areas to partner with their local clubs/associations and sporting event organisers to host a wide range of sporting events in their communities.

Federal Member for Maranoa David Littleproud said that all 17 LGAs across Maranoa were eligible to apply for the grant, which would help kick-start local events after the impact of the pandemic.

"Sport is often the glue that brings people together across the expansive Maranoa region and this program aims to fast-track the recovery from what's been a very challenging period for region," Mr Littleproud said.

"Local sporting clubs and associations play an incredibly important role in community strength and through this fund, the Australian Government is encouraging our community to come together and celebrate through sport.

"Staging these events will also benefit the small businesses in Maranoa that are central to our local economy."

Local government areas are encouraged to work with local sporting clubs and organisations to deliver fantastic sports events to their respective communities.

Events can range from "come and try days" to larger events including elite sporting exhibitions and state level competitions that engage the broader community.

"Community sport has been hit hard right across Australia as a result of the pandemic – but we all understand the power of local competition and the opportunities it presents to bring communities together," Mr Littleproud said.

"This fund will help to reboot many of the events that were cancelled or postponed and will encourage local government to be creative in how they re-engage with their local area."

Applications for the Regional Sport Events Fund are now open.

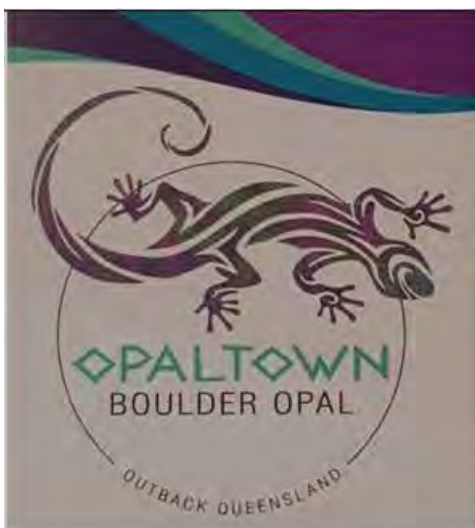
