In 1990 TV producer John Stainton filmed a television commercial at the Qld Reptile & Fauna Park in Beerwah Qld. Here he met **Steve Irwin** who he engaged to assist him by wrangling a crocodile for a scene in the commercial.

From that encounter John & Steve became best friends and went on to make some 350 hours of television and a movie together over the next 15 years.

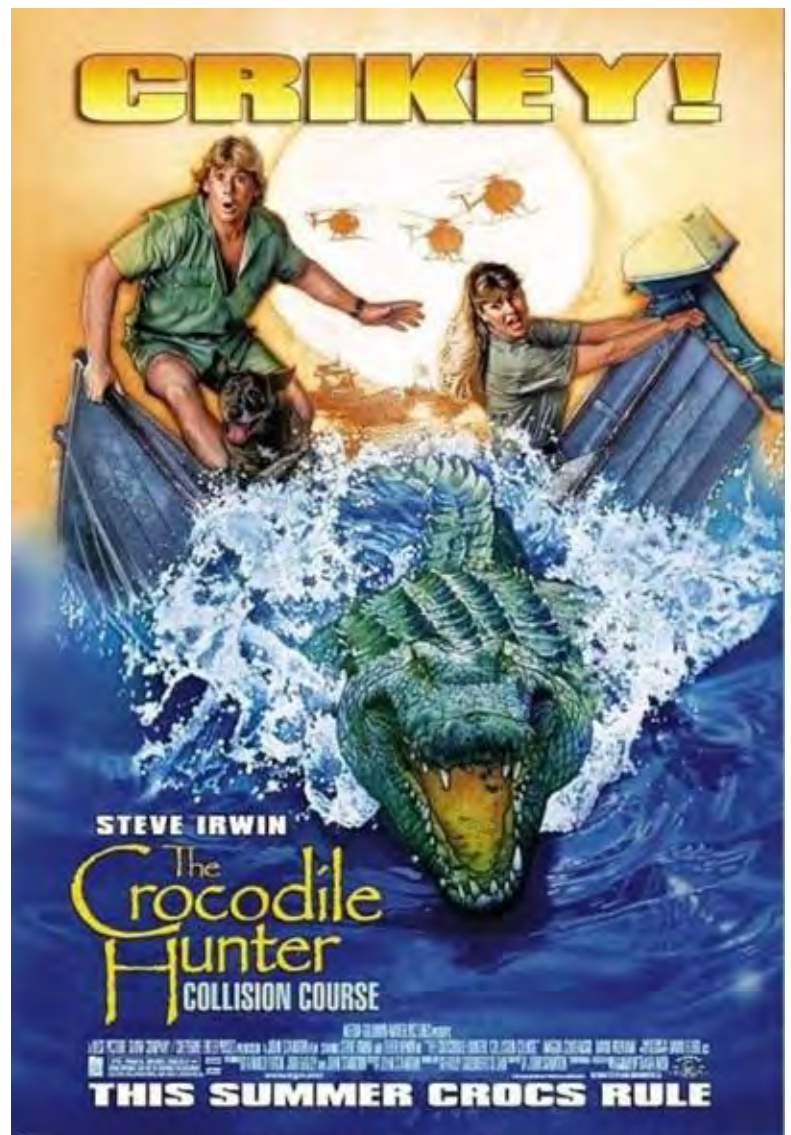
Their new television documentary series "**The Crocodile Hunter**", for the TEN NETWORK in **1992** was an instant success and they were commissioned to follow up immediately with more programs.

John decided to set the next episode in the outback featuring outback animals to broaden the appeal of the documentaries outside of crocodiles.

He chose Paul Neilsen in Winton, in 1992 to organise the base camp for the shoot and they filmed here a number of times over the years.

The series went on to capture the attention of the whole world and Steve became a household name in all countries and the top star of the US Discovery Network, **ANIMAL PLANET**.

In 2002 John & Steve made their first movie for **MGM** - "**COLLISION COURSE**" and were in the process of planning a 3D IMAX movie for Warner Bros. when Steve tragically died in 2006.
