Winton Shire Council Mayor's Message

How fast is the year going? It seems like Christmas was only yesterday. It's been a very busy month and hopefully this is the beginning of a big year.

The WWWWF is just around the corner and tickets are still on sale, it would be great for our local businesses to have a sell-out. The event managers have been working hard to implement our COVID safe plan. All the appropriate measures are been taken in consultation with QLD Health to make sure it's a safe environment and all the compliance measures are adhered to. You can still get your Local Tickets from the WMC.

I was glad to see WQPHN working closely with local health care providers administering the COVID 19 vaccinations to our aged care residents and staff at the hospital. They are our most vulnerable residents and it's reassuring to see them prioritised in the national roll out. Because our communities in Western Qld have a small population and long distances to travel we will be immunised together not in a phased roll out. Community vaccinations have commenced in the Central West with the Barcaldine region receiving the first round. We are waiting for notification from Qld Health as to when this will occur in Winton and will share this info as it is released.

Grasshoppers are still present in some parts of our shire causing grief to graziers that have received some rain recently. Minister Mark Furner visited town and properties, and spoke directly with land owners to hear their concerns first hand. A working group has been established to study grasshoppers and they've also authorised an emergency chemical for ground base spraying. Although spraying may not be ideal or cost effective it does give graziers options if they want. Unfortunately, we are coming to the end of our wet season and there hasn't been any good widespread rain across our shire.



We've been talking about a La-nina weather event for the last 6 months, but it's seemed to have bypassed us. Let's all keep our fingers crossed that we can get some decent rain in the coming weeks.

Councillors and I have had several meetings recently with state and federal ministers. We ventured across to Longreach to have a sit with the opposition leader David Crisafulli, Lachlan Millar and several mayors from our region

to discuss issues currently facing our shire. We also had Stirling Hinchliffe (Minister for Tourism) in town last weekend to visit some of our great attractions and talk to local operators. The minister is a big supporter of Western Qld and will be returning for the WWWWF.



As part of an Outback Way delegation I travelled to Canberra recently to lobby for funds to complete the seal from Winton to Laverton WA. The current funding will have 1800km of the 2700km journey sealed. If we can secure a guarantee of funding over the coming 5 years there'll be a bitumen road from Cairns/Townsville to Perth via Winton and Uluru. Once complete Winton will be a major cross road from North/South and East/West which will hopefully flow through to businesses and create opportunities for growth.



We have the races returning this weekend after a year off due to COVID. I'd like to wish the North Gregory Turf Club all the best and encourage everyone to get down and enjoy a great day at the races. The Diamantina Devils are also travelling to Charters Towers this weekend for their first full hit out of the season. Good luck to the mighty Devils and can't wait to support the boys through 2021. This is the beginning of a very busy events calendar with the WWWWF after Easter and culminating with Outback Festival in September and lots in between. People say there's nothing to do in the bush, but they've obviously never been to Winton!




