Geoff Mack took 16 mm cine film footage on his Bolex Camera. Geoff owned Carols Varieties in partnership with comedian Lucky Grills. Geoff's most notable achievement was to compose the world hit "I've been Everywhere".



Winton is said to be the birthplace of an earlier Australian Poem and Song "Waltzing Matilda". The 16 mm film footage has been enhanced with full Kodachrome colour restoration. There are freeze frames from the film footage. Maybe someone can identify that Holden Car and owner, in the first sequence. I was the Lowrey Organist with Carols from 1963-1964)

To be able to be a part of this amazing trip, the cars and bikes had to be built before January 1st 1920. Their final destination of Broome in Western Australia is a journey of over 4600kms.



The trip will take them through the middle of Australia going through towns like Winton, Mount Isa and Katherine. Then off to the WA/NT border. With Broome in their sights.

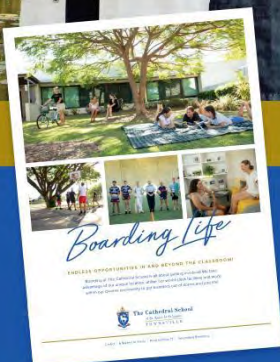

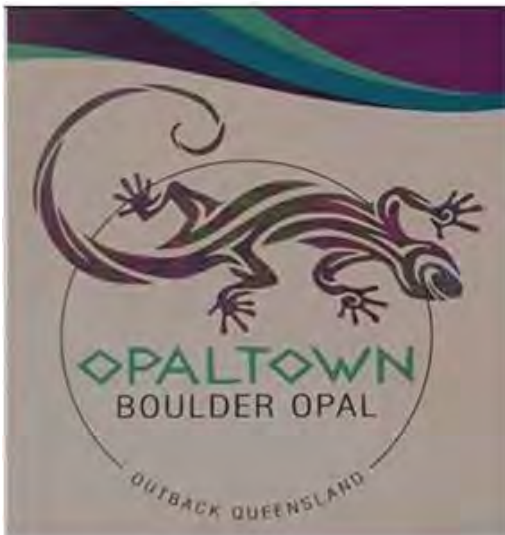
