ICPA – ISOLATED CHILDRENS PARENTS ASSOCIATION

Does the name Isolated Children’s Parents’ Association ring a bell? What about ICPA? Do you know anything at all about our volunteer, non-for-profit, apolitical organisation?

The ICPA Winton Branch is a dedicated group of individuals working towards equal education for our rural kids both in and out of town. But rather than tell you about our history, (check out our website – www.icpa.com.au), we would like to tell you about how ICPA is important to OUR Winton community and what we’ve done and will continue to do for our local children.

Firstly, our members’ issues concerning their children’s education - whether it is lack of specialist subjects, teacher retention issues, poor internet access or sporting disadvantages – are lobbied by ICPA State and Federal Councillors to relevant government ministers and departments. In the past two years at ICPA QLD State Conferences, our branch has lobbied for the following concerns and achieved great results.

- We fought for the retention of increased bandwidth for Distance Education subjects during the COVID-19 periods of home schooling – this motion was passed and Education Queensland agreed to maintain that level of bandwidth saving money for rural families.
- We also ensured that funding for the Longreach State High School’s hospitality facilities was fairly allocated to adequately upgrade the Big Red Truck for the benefit of the Winton State School senior students and our community.

Just thought of us that day.

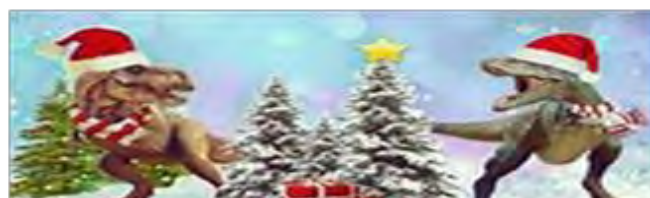

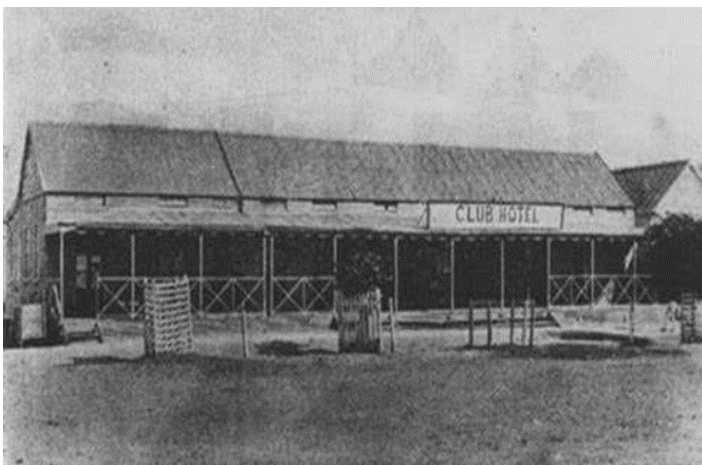


EXTRACT FROM

"THE WESTERN CHAMPION" – TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 1901

Winton Whiffs.

- For the first week in February the maximum temperature in Winton was 109 degrees. Less than half-an-inch of rain fell during January, as against 2in. in January 1900. Sheep from the various stations round are being trucked to the coast, where there have been splendid rains. Townsville people are growling because the total rainfall for January was only 14.91in. "The promises of a big rainfall for January," says the Bulletin, "which were so roBy at the beginning of the month, were not realised." A big rainfall in Townsville means about fifteen feet of rain and half the town washed into the Pacific Ocean. There was between Sin. and 4in. of rain between Brighton Downs and Diamantina Lakes last week.
- John Kearney, a lengthsman on the Winton line, was killed on Sunday night. He was riding on his tricycle and did not hear the approaching train, which overtook and cut him to pieces; The Gregory News supposes that the unfortunate man was inspecting his length at that time of night and, becoming "drowsy," did not hear the approaching train.
- The Rev. W. Scott is suffering from fever, and was unable to conduct the memorial services on Saturday. Much sympathy is felt for the rev. gentleman, who is a favorite with all.
- A Commonwealth Electoral League has been formed at Winton. A majority of the committee considered that Mr. J. S Henderson should be requisitioned to stand for the House of Representatives, and a wire was sent asking him to allow himself to be nominated.
- Ah Fat has been fined £30 or three months for selling opium to an aboriginal. The Chinese culprit appeared to be completely flabbergasted, and was heard to mutter as he marched to the cells, "Tirty pong! My cli! Tirty pong!!"
- The Winton Herald suggests that there should be a plebiscite of candidates nominated by the Leagues, and this would decide who was the most popular.

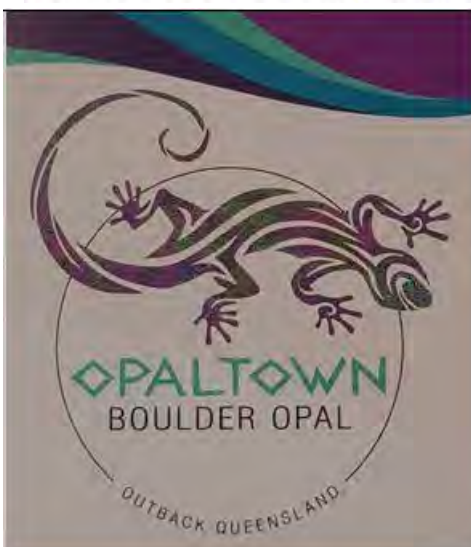
