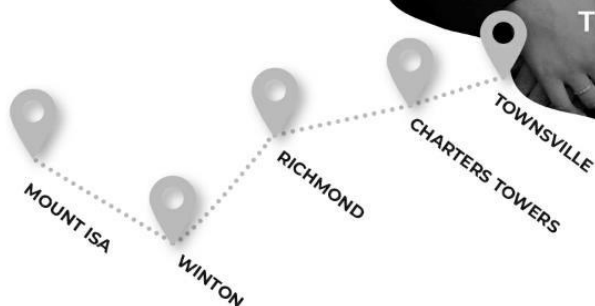

PUBLIC NOTICE – TOWN FOOTPATHS, ACCUMULATION OF OBJECTS AND OVERGROWN GRASS IN YARDS

Winton Shire Council would like to notify the public about the importance of town footpaths and yard maintenance. Council is responsible for all footpaths around town, therefore these areas need to be kept clean and free of any unwanted items. Two (2) annual clean-ups are provided each year, giving residents the opportunity to remove any unwanted items. These unwanted items are collected free of charge from Council Staff. PUBLIC CONSULTATION - WINTON SHIRE COUNCIL RECONCILIATION PLAN

A public consultation will be held for the Winton Shire Council Reconciliation Action Plan on Wednesday 15th September in Hollow Log Park at 6pm.

Council are looking to establish a Working Group to deliver the objectives of the Reconciliation Plan.

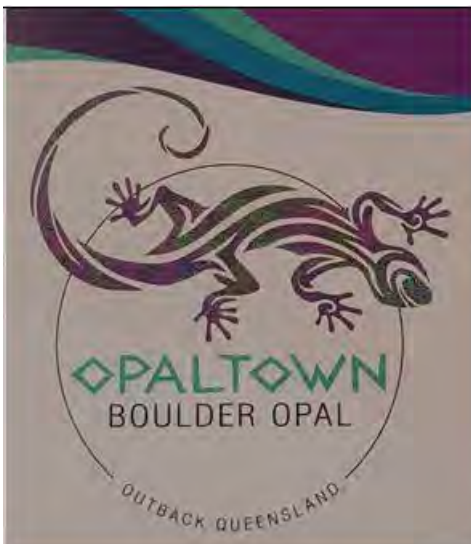
