BRONZE SWAGMAN UPDATE

April 30th saw the closing for entries to the **51st Bronze Swagman Award**. This year we received 121 entries with 8 new poets entering the competition with 16 poems. These 8 new poets are in the running for the Annual Tim Borthwick Memorial Prize sponsored by the Borthwick family. Poems have been submitted from all over Australia, America and France.

With a new committee this year there have been several exciting changes including gaining sponsorship which has enabled us to increase the prize money – a first for many many years, First Prize is now \$1100 plus the Bronze Swagman Trophy, Second Prize has been increased to \$350. We have also secured two highly experienced judges, Noel Stallard from Brisbane and Janine Haig from Chinchilla. Entries will soon be in their hands to judge for First Prize, Runner up and Highly Commended and choose poems to be printed in the annual book.

As a committee our hope is that the winner will be able to attend Winton later in the year to perform their poem at the Outback Festival celebrations to be held in September.






