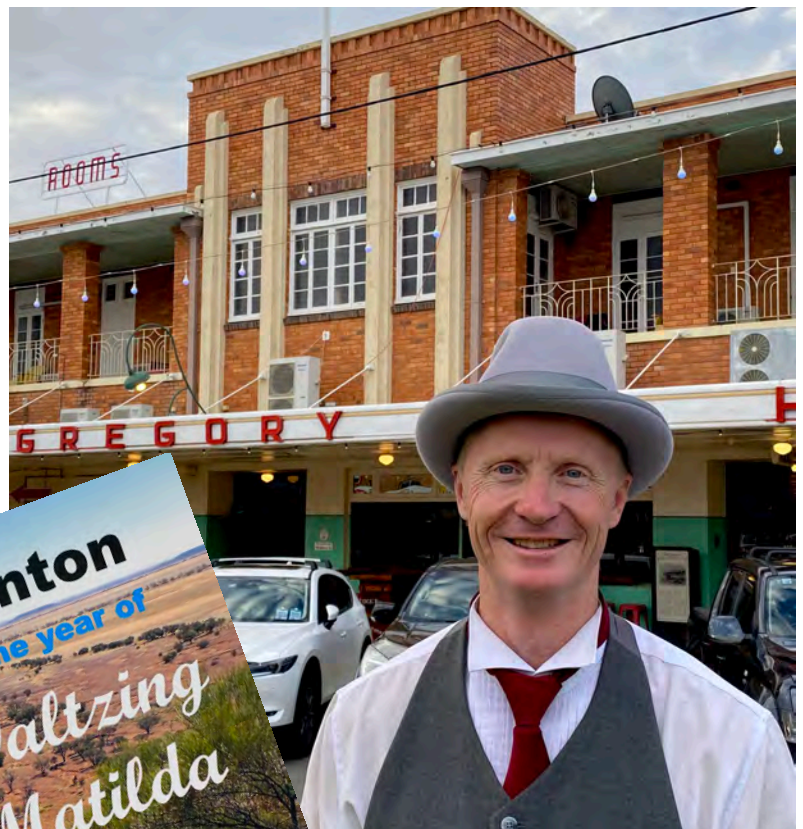


Gregory North - Waltzing his Matilda

Poet Gregory North has been making his annual pilgrimage to Winton for the past five years. “I’ve been performing as Banjo for the past four years”, Gregory said as he packed up and headed south for the summer. He has done 100 consecutive shows in the beer garden at The North Gregory Hotel as well as nightly shows at the Matilda Country Tourist Park.

This year was extra special for Gregory, he launched his book ***Winton in the year of WALTZING MATILDA 1895 – 96.***

Doing research for his book taught Gregory lots. “I learnt that in 1895, Winton was a thriving town bustling with shearers, drovers and squatters. Waltzing Matilda could have been written in August 1895 or possibly even January of 1896. Travel to Winton from outside Queensland was by steamship, railway from Rockhampton to Longreach and then Cobb & Co horse drawn coach. It was a major undertaking just to get to Winton - not for the faint-hearted or those on a low income. The coming of the railway (first surveyed from Hughenden in 1895), the completion of the artesian bore (in June 1895) and the visit of the Premier of Queensland (Hugh Muir Nelson) and Railways Minister Robert Philp (of Burns and Philp fame) were



the big news stories of the year”.

Over summer Gregory attends various festivals - folk, country music, poetry as well as doing gigs and the occasional school show. The last couple of years he has performed on the Cruisin' Country South Pacific cruise aboard a Royal Caribbean liner. He also enjoys restoring and driving his 1968 Volkswagen Beetles (he has two). He also has a 1991 Audi 90 that he loves to drive too. A bit of mountain biking and bushwalking happens when he gets around to it. Gregory North will be back in Winton in 2021 from Mothers' Day and will stay until end of September.

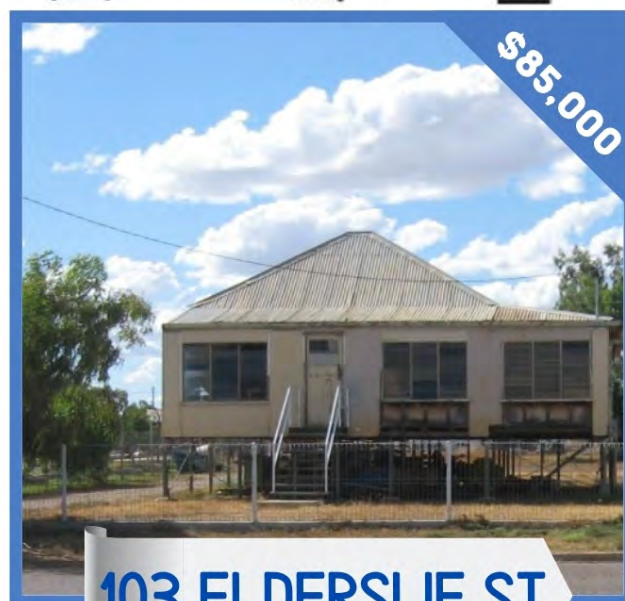

Top ten tips for parents



1. When your child wants to show you something, stop what you are doing and pay attention. It's important to spend frequent, small amounts of time with your child doing things that you both enjoy.

2. Give your child lots of physical affection. Children often like hugs, cuddles, and holding hands.

3. Talk to your child about things he/she is interested in and talk about your day too.

4. Give your child lots of descriptive praise when they do something that you would like to see more of, e.g., "Thank you for doing what I asked straight away".

5. Children are more likely to misbehave when they are bored so provide lots of indoor and outdoor activities for your child, e.g., building blocks, colouring in, cardboard boxes, dress ups, cubby houses, etc.

6. Teach your child new skills by first showing the skill yourself, then giving your child opportunities to learn the new skill. For example, speak politely to each other in the home.

Then, prompt your child to speak politely (e.g., say "please" or "thank you"), and praise your child for their efforts.

7. Set clear limits on your child's behaviour. Sit down and have a family discussion on the rules in the home. Let your child know what the consequences will be if they break the rules.

8. If your child misbehaves, stay calm and give them a clear instruction to stop misbehaving and tell them what you would like them to do instead (e.g., "Stop fighting; play nicely with each other"). Praise your child if they stop. If they do not stop, follow through with an appropriate consequence.

9. Have realistic expectations. All children misbehave at times and it is inevitable that you will have some discipline hassles. Trying to be the perfect parent can set you up for frustration and disappointment.

10. Look after yourself. It is difficult to be a calm, relaxed parent if you are stressed, anxious, or depressed. Try to find time every week to let yourself unwind or do something that you enjoy.
