

These pictures of the last touring Vaudeville Variety Show Carols...I was Lowrey Organist with the show in 1963 and 1964.....this series was taken in 1964.....Here is the Carols Tent in Winton....The show was joined by showmen who set up their sideshows near the Carols Tent at Winton. My Holden SW/Panel Van is to the left and that

Luxurious white Chevy was Lucky Grills personal car. Lucky Grills and Geoff Mack co-owned the show.



Carol's Varieties was well attended when the touring show was on in Winton in the early to mid-1960's.

I'm sure some will remember Geoff Mack and his wife Tabbi Francis. Geoff and Tabbi appeared on stage, radio and television together since the 1950's. Firstly in Europe and then in Australia. Tabbi was a Comedienne and Geoff a singer/

songwriter.

Just over 60 years ago Geoff was to write a song which has not only become a world hit, but an evergreen and he did this in the Queensland town of Currumbin, outside the Bird Sanctuary.

In 1959 Geoff was sitting in their car in Currumbin. Geoff had 3 Road Maps.

Geoff had already written songs which he performed himself and some had already been published.

He had his notebook and began jotting down the names which rhymed on the Australian Road Maps. This gave Geoff a great idea for a song which he was to name "I've been Everywhere". A record producer loved it and set the wheels in motion for what was to become a worldwide hit song.

The first version was recorded by Lucky Starr and soon became number 1 in Australia. Geoff sang it for a several months at various venues including the Hotel Coolangatta. (And he kept on singing his songs right into the 21st century). Geoff was given the nickname "TangleTongue" as he was able to sing all those Australian names "rapidly" in this unique song. Geoff passed away in 2017 well into his 90's and Tabbi left us in 2020. They were personal friends. I was with their show Carols Varieties in 1963 and 1964 as Lowrey Organist and we kept in touch over the years.

They performed at other venues on the gold Coast of Queensland including Claude Carnell's Playroom Cabaret and the Hotel Grande Labrador.
