Promote a clear message of no tolerance of domestic and family violence in Queensland communities;


Ensure those who are experiencing domestic and family violence know how to access help and support;

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PREVENTION MONTH

Recognising that the signs don't always present as physical and knowing where to get support when you or someone you know needs it.

1 INTENSITY

Someone you just met exhibits the following behavior: **LYING** or exaggerating, **INSISTING** you move in/get married/have kids immediately, trying to win over friends and family, **OVER THE TOP** gestures like expensive gifts/dates, extreme love letters, sweeping you off your feet, **BOMBARDING** you with texts and emails, behaving obsessively and non stop calls.

2 JEALOUSY

Behaving **IRRATIONAL**LY when you get a promotion, job or new friend, becoming **ANGRY** when you speak to the opposite sex, persistently **ACCUSING** you of cheating, resenting your time with friends, family, coworkers or activities, **DEMANDING** to know private details of your life.

3 CONTROL

TELLING you how to dress, when to speak or what to think, showing up **UNINVITED** at your home, school, or job, **CHECKING** your cell phone, emails, Facebook, going through your belongings, timing/**FOLLOWING** you, controlling/withholding money, sexually coercing you.

4 ISOLATION

INSISTING you only spend time with them, making you emotionally, psychologically or financially **DEPENDENT**, preventing you from seeing your friends, family or children, **FORBIDDING** you from going anywhere or speaking to anyone, keeping you home.

5 BLAME

Making you feel **GUILTY** and responsible for their aggressive or **DESTRUCTIVE** behavior, blaming the world or you for their **PROBLEMS**, always saying, "This is your **FAULT**" or "You made me do this."

6 CRITICISM

Calling you overweight, **UGLY**, **STUPID** or crazy, ridiculing your beliefs, ambitions or friends, claiming they're the only one who really cares about you, making you feel bad about yourself, **BRAINWASHING** you to feel worthless, accusing you of being a bad parent.

7 ANGER

OVERREACTING to small problems, frequently losing control, violent **OUTBURSTS**, having severe mood swings, drinking or partying excessively when upset, **THREATENING** to hurt you or loved ones, picking **FIGHTS**, having a history of violent behavior and making you feel **AFRAID**.

8 SABOTAGE

Making you **MISS** work or school by starting a fight or having a **MELTDOWN**, being needy when you're busy or doing well, making you believe you're crazy, alone or helpless, **HIDING** your money, keys or phone, stealing your belongings, **DESTROYING** your self-esteem.

There is no justification for abuse. If your partner either threatens or does physically assault you, which includes shoving or pushing, it will only get worse. Inform the authorities, tell your friends or family, and call the national domestic abuse hotline immediately. There are many people who care and want to help you.

Ageing in the Outback

With the Pandemic Restrictions in place Winton Community and Aged Care Services held their monthly meeting for April via a teleconference. Although numbers were down the Executive Members thought it was essential to keep the momentum of the group as we continue to advance our goals. It is hoped before the next meeting that we can work together if we are still under restrictions to assist others to be confident in connecting.

There were a number of key items to discuss including establishing the identity of the organisation through its new logo. The judging panel of Mrs Stephanie Greenwood, Mayor Gavin Baskett and Councillor Sandy Gillies selected from the submissions a design by Bill O'Brien with his "Ageing in the Outback" logo. Bill will receive a \$100 voucher donated by the Fraser family to be used at a nominated local business.

The organisation contacted the Winton Shire Council in relation to a number of matters from the previous meeting including:

- Securing the Land Parcel for the building which was approved
- Ability to receive the donation of funds from unclaimed common cattle which was approved.
- The request in relation to accessing the fundraising money to be put into the Organisations fundraising account was not approved unless the organisation had set up a designated trust account solely for the approximate \$39,000 that Council holds for the construction of Jessamine Place. The organisation decided that it was not viable for them to set up an account just for the Council funds but are seeking confirmation from Council that these funds are there and earning interest for the organisation once building commences.
- We have also asked Council to update the original target at the Neighbourhood Centre to reflect the current fundraising balance and we will also update it as we make significant changes to the balance.

The organisation has a fundraising account solely for funds to construct the building which will not be used for any other purpose other than the actual building and can be added to as donations come in. We are currently waiting on the finalisation of the Tax deductible status however if you want to donate now donations can be made to the following bank account:



The Western Qld PHN has approved the Feasibility Study and it should commence in the next month and take approximately 8-12 weeks to complete. The consultant Peter Larter may need to talk to various people in the community to collect information for the study and we will be in contact with you.

WINTON “BUY LOCAL” GIFT CARDS

Have you just moved to town? You may be eligible for a “Buy Local” Gift Card.

Cards will be distributed from the Winton Shire Council Main Office. Please bring proof of residing in Winton.

If you do not wish to obtain a Buy Local Card for yourself, you can give it to a Local Community group in need.

The Buy Local Card is available from the Council Administration Office.

The guidelines for the distribution of the Winton “Buy Local” Cash Card are as follows: -

- a) Each Winton ‘Buy Local’ Gift Card will be pre-loaded with \$300 and shall be valid for a period of 12 months;
- b) The cards will only be valid within the Winton Shire Council area;
- c) To be eligible to receive a Winton ‘Buy Local’ Gift Card, the resident’s name must be listed on the current Electoral Roll for the Winton Shire Council or be a resident with proof of residing in Winton;
- d) Cards will be distributed from the Winton Shire Council Main Office;
- e) Before a card is issued, the resident will need to provide a form of identification (e.g. drivers licence, Medicare card, pension card etc.) satisfactory to staff and must sign for the card;
- f) Only 1 card will be issued per person, and lost cards will not be replaced;
- g) Cards will be issued to an individual in person only;

To be eligible to receive a card, the resident must be over 18 years of age.

Following the February 2019 Monsoon Flood disaster, the Winton Shire Council was provided with Commonwealth Category D – Exceptional Circumstances funding to the value of \$1m. From this funding, the North-West Queensland Flood Disaster Carcass Disposal Strategic Master Plan was developed, and Council administered payments of \$5,000 per property to assist with carcass disposals. A total of \$685,000 was paid to eligible landowners within the Winton Shire. This left a balance of \$315,000 to be used on priorities deemed most urgent to Council associated with the event.

After much consideration, Council decided to use the balance of the funding on purchasing and distributing pre-loaded Winton ‘Buy Local’ gift cards (1,000 cards @ \$300 plus costs) for community members within the shire. Following this flood event, Council considered our **local businesses** were greatly disadvantaged, even though they suffered minimal flood damage, the town was isolated, and the flow of visitors stopped. Compensation was not available to offset this financial hardship so the Winton ‘Buy Local’ gift card was considered the best option to support our community and local businesses.

Each Winton ‘Buy Local’ Gift Card will be pre-loaded with \$300 and shall be valid for a period of 12 months from 15 October 2019.
