SUMMARY

This report outlines the process for the procurement of gravel for the Winton-Richmond Road Pavement Reconstruction Project. The project requires 19,194m3 of gravel to be supplied and delivered between Ch. 100km to Ch.117.21kms at the WQ35 Alt 2 Specification. Winton Shire Council cannot undertake these works as it requires special crushing equipment to obtain the required specification. The works are therefore required to be contracted out.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT the report be received.
- 2. THAT Council award WSCQ-2021-20, Supply & Delivery of Gravel Richmond Road to Ayrshire Hills Quarry (T/A Dan's Tippers) for the value of \$734,427.42 (GST Exclusive).

REPORT

Council was invited by the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) to tender on the betterment project for the Winton / Richmond Road. This involves reconstructing the existing pavement of the road between Ch. 100 km and Ch. 117.210 km. Council was informed to tender for the project on 4 February 2021 and the contract was awarded recently.

To complete the works, Council requires 19,194 cubic metres of gravel at the WQ35 Alt 2 specification. As the Council Works Department do not have the required equipment to crush the raw gravel to specification, Council sought quotations from our bulk materials pre-qualified suppliers list. On 24 February 2021, the quotation was advertised on Vendorpanel for 16 days to Winton Shire Council's Prequalified Supplier List for Bulk Materials. All suppliers were selected and informed on how to retrieve the document.

Suppliers responses have been evaluated against the four (4) selection criteria below;

The Two (2) responses received are as below:

Ayrshire Hills Quarry (T/A Dan's Tippers, Winton)

• Gromac Quarries (Richmond)

All quotes were evaluated against the above criteria. Both submissions had missing administrative documents. Given the urgency of this supply of material, clarification was sought from Council's external auditors, confirming the correct process (additional information to be provided at the meeting, if required). Both respondents have now submitted all required administrative documents, which did not affect the pricing schedule.

Based on the above evaluation, it is recommended that Council award 'WSCQ-2021- 20 Supply and Deliver Gravel to the Winton Richmond Road Ch. 100 to Ch.117.210' to *Ayrshire Hills Quarry* (T/A Dan's Tippers) as they are a local company and were the most competitive.

SUMMARY

The 2020-21 reseal budget is \$150,000 for rural roads and \$300,000 for town streets. In addition, Council has allocated \$236,000 of LRCI phase 2 funding for reseals. In March, \$110,000 has been spent on Asphalting of carparks leaving a total of \$576,000 recommended for reseals for 2020-21.

Council tendered the works state-wide on Local Buy and Vendor Panel receiving 6 conforming tenders of which AusTek Asphalt was the best value for money overall at \$387,962.36 (ex GST). This was based on the original budget of \$450,000.

It is recommended that Council increase the scope of works to allocate the additional funding provided by LRCI phase 2 to complete a more comprehensive reseal program.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. THAT Council receive the report.
- 2. THAT Council award tender WSCT-2021-24 Resealing Program 2021 to AusTek Asphalt for \$387,962.36 (GST exclusive).
- 3. THAT Council increase the scope of works to include the projects identified for funding through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program Phase 2.

REPORT

Council has budgeted \$300,000 for town reseals and \$150,000 for rural reseals which is funded from TIDS/R2R. In early 2021, Council allocated \$236,000 towards resealing under the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program – Phase 2. Of this, \$110,000 has been utilised for the asphalt works at the Childcare Centre and Neighbourhood Centre. While the LRCIP phase 2 funding needs to be spent before December 2021, now is the ideal time to use this funding by

combining it with the 2020-21 reseal program – noting that the LRCIP phase 2 funding is included in the 2020-21 revised budget.

Accordingly, a total of \$576,000 is recommended for reseals for 2020-21.

Council tendered the 2020-21 reseal program in late February with Tenders closing on 12 March 2021. This was prior to the LRCIP phase 2 funding application being submitted (and approved). The works identified is as per table 1. Of these works, Council has an obligation under TIDS/R2R to complete the Nisbet Street and Blomfield Street works.

SUMMARY

This report outlines the tender, evaluation process and recommendation for WSCT-2021-25 Construction of Concrete Floodway's.

RECOMMENDATION

- THAT the report be received
- 2. THAT Council award tender WSCT-2021-25 Construction of Concrete Floodway to:

Mann Made Constructions - Site 1: Corfield Richmond Road Chainage 26.84km (Sutton Creek) for \$140,597.00 (GST Exclusive);

Stockham Building Services - Sites 2, 3, and 4: Diamantina River Road Western Channels, for \$123,930.00 (GST Exclusive);

Stockham Building Services - Sites 5 & 6 Diamantina River Road Chainage 46.5 and 49.25km for \$161,109.00 (GST Exclusive).

REPORT

During 2019, Winton and surrounding areas endured a flood event that caused damage to roads and infrastructure. After these events, crews surveyed the extent of damage and the severity of the damage. During and subsequent to these inspections, it was noted six locations within the Shire were sites for betterment with the proposed construction of concrete floodways.

The location of these floodways was submitted to the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (see map below):

Site 1: Corfield / Richmond Road Chainage 26.84km (Sutton Creek), Sites 2, 3, and 4: Diamantina River Road Western Channels, Sites 5 & 6 Diamantina River Road Chainage 46.5 and 49.25km.

On 15 February 2021, tenders were advertised for the Construction of Concrete Floodways via the Winton Herald. Longreach Leader and Vendorpanel.

The tenders covered the construction of several concrete floodways within the Shire. Seven (7) submissions were received allowing the tenderers the option to price on the floodways as a separable portion or as a combined portion.
